

QUALMEDICA RESEARCH OPPORTUNITY

Type 2 Diabetes – Qualmedica is currently enrolling for two clinical trials for type 2 diabetes in adults as follows:

- Clinical trial for Type 2 Diabetes in Adults with CV Risk Factors This is an open-label comparator study of a daily oral medication versus insulin glargine injection in patients with T2 diabetes and a risk of cardiovascular disease. This is a phase III study for adults 18 years and older.
- 2) Clinical trial for Type 2 Diabetes in Adults This SURPASS-EARLY study aims to investigate the efficacy and safety of Mounjaro in participants with type 2 diabetes compared to other existing treatment options when treatment is initiated early. This is a phase IV trial. Currently enrolling for adults 18 years and older.
