A requirement for any organization with an active Institutional Review Board (IRB) is to do an annual review of all clinical trials/ research projects that have been approved and are still active. If you are the principal investigator for an active clinical trial or project has either approved or acknowledged though Med Center #1 IRB, you will be receiving a request to update the IRB on the status of the project. This is a requirement and failure to complete this necessary paperwork will result in the project being terminated. Please watch your email for more information about this important review process.

Dr. Karan Singh, Dr. Priyanka Bhatt, and Jackson Horn, WKHL Research Assistant are investigators in the multicenter Resuscitative TEE Collaborative Registry. Two abstracts, *Development and Implementation of a Multicenter Registry for Resuscitation-Focused Transesophageal Echocardiography* and *Deep Learning Detection of Chest Compression Location Using Transesophageal Echocardiography* were accepted for publication at the American Heart Association/ Circulation journal.

UK COLLEGE OF MEDICINE, STUDENT RESEARCH SHOWCASE




