In December, the Medical Center #1 IRB Committee met for the annual review of the approved research projects. At the meeting, there were 63 studies presented with 36 either re-approved or reacknowledged; 21 terminated the projects as were completed, and 6 terminated by the principal investigator. The Committee was very impressed not only by the number, but the quality of the projects and how many had been completed. Each year, we continue to see an increase in the number of projects, as there were 54 in 2022 and 30 in 2021.
